### **Personal Questions**

1. How would you describe your working style on the day? Do they bring a calm presence or a high-energy "director" vibe?
2. Do you shoot digital, film, or a hybrid of both?
3. What do you love most about shooting weddings in the Okanagan/BC/your wedding location?
4. How do you help couples who feel awkward in front of the camera?

### **Photography Style & Inspiration**

1. How would you describe your photography style?
2. Can we see a full gallery from a venue similar to ours?
3. How much of your work is candid versus directed?

### **In Case of Emergency**

1. What is your backup plan for equipment (and yourself)?
2. How do you handle difficult lighting or weather?
3. How is our digital data stored and protected after the wedding?

### **Packages & Logistics**

1. What is included in your collections? Are engagement sessions, second shooters, or heirloom albums included?
2. How many photos will we receive, and what is the turnaround time?
3. Do we get full printing rights to our images?
4. What information do you need from us before the wedding?
